





Title 12, Chapter 19, Article 2, Code of Alabama 1975, generally governs the amount and manner of distribution of docket fees which shall be assessed and collected in district and circuit courts throughout the state. The docket fees are uniform throughout the state, except in those counties where additional court costs are authorized by local act. This chart outlines the docket fees and other fees and monies authorized by the statute to be collected. The distribution of the fees as required by the statute is set forth beside each fee. Please note that 'X' in the account code indicates multiple account codes authorized by the statute (e.g. XXXX indicates that a court fee cost for a county, state or municipal maintenance, library or traffic offense and instead of listing multiple account codes for the same statute (ST), CT), MT(D) etc. a generic account code was used.

2 If preliminary hearing was requested in the district court, also collect and disburse fee in circuit court.
3 Additional Plaintiff Fee shall not be charged for plaintiff suing for loss of consortium - 12-19-71(B)
4 The solicitor's fee shall be collected in all criminal cases in the juvenile, district, circuit and municipal courts where the defendant is adjudged guilty, a bond forfeited, a penalty imposed, or where there is a finding any alias or capias warrant of arrest.
