**RESPONSE TO QUESTION RAISED REGARDING THE “INSURANCE COVERAGE” REQUIREMENTS
SET FORTH IN SECTION 6.6 OF THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR CASE MANAGEMENT
SOLUTION**

The Administrative Office of Courts (“AOC”) received a question regarding the meaning of the reference to Umbrella Liability insurance coverage set for in Section 6.6 of the Request for Proposal for Case Management Solution (“RFP”). In response, the AOC states as follows:

The reference to “Umbrella Liability” in Section 6.6 of the RFP simply means that the total insurance coverage amount required of Selected Vendor, including Umbrella Liability coverage, must meet the one million (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence coverage requirement set forth in Section 6.6. For example, Selected Vendor could meet the one million (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence coverage requirement if its insurance coverage consisted of \$500,000 in coverage plus an additional \$500,000 in umbrella liability coverage as long as the total coverage amount meets the one million (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence coverage requirement and the total coverage amount applies to the other coverage requirements set forth in Section 6.6 (e.g., Comprehensive General Liability, Professional Liability (covering errors and omissions), Worker’s Compensation Employer’s Liability, and insurance covering claims regarding infringement of intellectual property).
