Extending Orders Pertaining to Workers' Compensation Cases

This Court, having fully considered the subsequent Administrative Order issued by this Court on December 21, 2020, extending the first Administrative Order until April 30, 2021, or further order of this Court; and

This Court, having fully considered the subsequent Administrative Order issued by this Court on April 28, 2021, further extending the first Administrative Order until July 29, 2021, or further order of this Court; and

This Court, having fully considered the subsequent Administrative Order issued by this Court on July 28, 2021, further extending the first Administrative Order until October 29, 2021, or further order of this Court,

IT IS ORDERED that the Administrative Order issued by Chief Justice Parker on March 18, 2020, is further extended until December 31, 2021, or further order of this Court.
