RE: Next Meeting - FRIDAY, MARCH 31, 2006

This memorandum is for the purpose of notifying each of you that the next Committee meeting is scheduled for **Friday, March 31, 2006, beginning at 10:00 a.m., to be held in the Mezzanine Classroom of the Heflin-Torbert Judicial Building, Montgomery (same Judicial Building as previous meetings, but renamed)**. Parking is available in the Center for Commerce deck with the entrance on Hull Street roughly two blocks south of the Building. The parking deck code for March is 320*.

The main purposes of the March 31, 2006, meeting of the Committee are as follows: (1) to review the comparative study being conducted by R. Mark Rogers of Economic Consulting of Peachtree City, GA; and (2) to review a proposal by Committee member Steve Arnold, Esq., for amending Rule 32, Alabama Rules of Judicial Administration (the Child Support Guidelines rule), concerning factoring health insurance premiums into the child support formula.

Mr. Rogers plans to be available at the meeting to answer any questions the Committee members may have concerning his study. A representative of Policy Studies, Inc. (PSI) may be asked to be available as well, since PSI's report from February, 2004, is being compared. Once the comparative study

is completed, you will receive a copy of it, as well as a copy of Mr. Arnold's proposal, in advance of the meeting for review.
