

Brief on CS 42 Forms – By children's names

Emily and Elizabeth:

Children from client's first marriage. He is self-employed, has re-married, and has one child with his current wife. Oldest child, Elizabeth, is in her first year of college. Insurance premium is \$1100.00 for five people. If given full credit for the entire premium on the CS 42, child support for one child would be \$357.00. If insurance premium credit is only for two (2) children of the first marriage (one child at home with first wife, and one child away at school), and child support for only one child (he is paying a portion of college expenses instead of child support) would increase from \$357.00 to \$615.00.

Arik and Erinque:

Modification of current order which is several years old. Family coverage for noncustodial parent, her new husband, and the two children is \$842.00. Percentage for children only is \$440.00. Full premium cost for insurance - child support would be \$507.00. Children's percent only for cost of insurance increases child support to \$663.00.

Tarah and Tyler:

Modification. Full family coverage through new wife's employer covers non-custodial dad, new wife, and child of their marriage as well as the children of the first marriage is \$341.00 (I think in my example, I put the amount under child care and not insurance). Coverage for the two children under the Order being modified is \$136.00. Only paying child support for one child as the other is in tech school which both parents are paying a portion. Changes child support from \$581.00 to \$618.00

Ann Marie and Jacob:

Original Divorce. Both parents make the same income and no day care incurred by either party. \$500.00 is for Mom and two children. \$350 is children's percentage only. Changes child support owed to Mom from Dad from \$963.00 to \$888.00.
